## DISCIPLE MAKING MOVEMENTS

- Pray this Eid many Afghan Muslims would read the story of Abraham found in the Torah (Bible); pray for **spiritual sight** as they hear the story.
- Pray that through the shared 'prophet' stories, many Muslims would find Christ, the One the prophets were all pointing to, and **respond by taking up their cross and following Him**. (Luke 14:27)
- Pray for many groups to go through the 'Creation to Christ' stories, discovering Truth about God and allowing it to **change their lives** and **passing on these stories** to others as they learn them; pray for people in these **groups to start more groups** of people discovery God through the scriptures.
- Pray for God's Word to makes sense to those who hear it, that **the Holy Spirit would teach and instruct them**, leading them and their communities into all Truth.
- Pray for the **conviction of sin** for Afghans and a deep **realisation of their need** of the perfect Lamb of God to take their place and make them right with God.
- Pray for the response from every Afghan who believes in Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of God, to **respond** to His sacrifice with **complete abandonment to Him**; that they would follow Him no matter the cost, learn to discern and **follow His voice wherever He may lead** and have the joy of **making more disciples**.
- Pray that the worthiness of Christ would compel them to **spread seeds of the Kingdom abundantly**.

## THE SACRIFICE OF GOD'S CHILDREN

- Thank God** for every disciple who has given up everything to make His name known among Afghans; pray that their labour and prayers would be like a **seed that grows up to produce a great harvest** of disciples among Afghans. (Mark 4:26-29)
- Pray God would continue to **raise up men and women of FAITH**, who would **set their hope in life after the resurrection**, no matter what trials they may have to pass through. (Heb 11:11, 35-40)

-Pray for faith and confident hope in the Lord that is not dependent on circumstances but pray that Afghans would be like a **tree planted along a river bank** with roots that reach deep into the water whose **leaves stay green**, even in heat and long months of drought, and who **never stop producing fruit**. (Jeremiah 17:8)

-**Pray for those suffering for bearing Christ's name**, to be reminded of the blessing this is, according to the scriptures, for the glorious Spirit of God rests upon them; pray they would **live under the honour God bestows on them**, not the yoke of shame from the community. (1 Peter 4: 13, 16)

## RESPONDING TO THE GREATEST SACRIFICE

*Read & pray from... 1 Peter 1:13-25*

-Pray for Afghans to **live as obedient children of our Father**, not slipping back into old habits of ways that satisfy the flesh. (1 Pet 1:14)

-Thank God for the many Afghans **He has and WILL save from an empty life** through the blood of Christ; pray they live with **reverent fear of God** and as temporary residents here on earth, not storing up treasures that will fade but **treasure that will last for ever**. (1 Peter 1:17-19)

-Pray Afghans for respond to Christ's sacrifice by **displaying sincere love to one another**, that **healing would come across people groups** as they live out of their new identity. They would put to death old **generational patterns** of interacting and take up **genuine love and forgiveness**. (1 Peter 1:22)
